Athens  
 Depart Winnipeg for your overnight flight to Athens.

### Day 2

Athens  
 Day at leisure.

### Day 3

Athens  
 Day at leisure. This evening, meet your tour director and the group for a welcome drink. **(B)**

### Day 4

Athens  
 Today's tour includes the Acropolis and the Panathenaic Stadium. Remainder of day at leisure. **(B)**

### Day 5

Nauplia  
 Cross the canal to ancient Corinth. Enjoy free time in Mycenae for lunch, then visit the excavations and museum. In Epidaurus, see the 2,300-year-old open-air auditorium before continuing to Nauplia. **(B/D)**

### Day 6

Olympia  
 Take a scenic drive through the Arkadian Mountains, then visit Olympia's archaeological site and museum. Attend a cooking demonstration this evening to learn how to make traditional Greek *tzatziki*. **(B/D)**

### Day 7

Delphi  
 Arrive in Delphi to see the excavations and museum. This evening, join the Globus Local Favorite experience and learn how to dance the *sirtaki* while sipping *ouzo*. **(B/D)**

### Day 8

Meteora  
 Drive to Kalabaka to visit the Varlaam and St. Stephen's Monasteries. **(B/D)**

### Day 9

Athens  
 Stop at the battle site in Thermopylae, then arrive in Athens. Remaining day at leisure. **(B)**

### Day 10

Mykonos  
 Take a scenic ferry from Piraeus. Enjoy a walking tour that includes the Church of Agia Kiriaki and an *amygdalota* (traditional Greek almond cookie) tasting. Savour a dinner of local specialties. **(B/D)**

 Ferry to Santorini to explore the picturesque island. **(B/D)**

 Fly to Athens for a final day at leisure. **(B)**
